Download Instructions:

- 1. Insert a USB memory device, into your PC's USB port. (The USB memory device MUST be formatted as "FAT")
- 2. Double click the file: "dvd_soft_HPxxx_xxxxxx.zip" to open the compressed file. It will open in a window similar to this:

3. Click on "Extract" to select where you want to save the files. Your USB memory device should appear with a name such as "Removable Disk" or with the brand name of the device. Click on the drive option for your USB memory device, and click "Extract"

*Note – Do not Extract the Firmware update file to any sub-folder on the USB memory device. The Firmware update file must be in the root directory.

Before removing your USB memory device from the computer, ensure that you "Safely Remove" it. Click on the icon that appears like this:

and is labeled "Safely Remove Hardware".

5. A small submenu will appear saying: "Stop USB Mass Storage Device" (a series of Drive letters may also be listed). A confirmation screen should appear, letting you know it is safe to remove the USB memory device.



- 6. Physically remove your USB memory device from the USB port on your computer.
- 7. Follow the steps on the next page to perform the Firmware Upgrade of your Sharp Blu-ray player.

Software Update Settings

In this player, the software version can be updated using either one of the following methods.

- Manual Update from Network
- Manual Update from USB memory device

Manual Update from Network

This function allows you to perform the update operation by accessing an Internet connection manually to check if there is a new firmware version.

NOTE

- Make sure that the LAN cable is connected to this player if a wired Internet connection is made. Make sure that the wireless router/access point is connected to the Internet if a wireless Internet connection is made. (See pages 20–21.)
- Make sure to perform the communication settings. (See pages 43–46.)
- It may take time to access and download the update depending on the Internet connection and other factors.

 While downloading or updating the software, do not remove the LAN cable when it is used for the Internet connection, do not unplug the AC cord, do not remove any cables from the router/access point and do not turn off the router/access point.



- 1 Press HOME to display the menu screen.
- 2 Press ▲/▼ to select "Settings", then press ► or ENTER.
- 3 Press ▲/▼ to select "Software Update Settings", then press ► or ENTER.
- 4 Press ► or ENTER to move to the menu to the right.
- 5 Press ▲/▼ to select "Network", then press ENTER.

- 6 During access to the network and checking the latest version of firmware, "Accessing" blinks.
 - The current version of this unit software and the latest version of the update file on the network are displayed when latest version of firmware has been found. To update this player software with update file, select "Yes", and go to step 7.

Manual Update from USB memory device

This function allows software updates by inserting a USB memory device with the update file into the USB terminal on this player.

- When a software update is performed, the software update data must be written onto the USB memory device in advance using a PC.
- The USB memory device must be clear of all files except software update data to allow new software uploading.

- The screen shown in part (2) of step 9 will be automatically displayed. (Go to part (2) of step 9.)
- If "No" is selected in part (2) of step 9 and wish to update the software manually, perform the operations from step 3.
- **3** Press **HOME** to display the menu screen.
- 4 Press \blacktriangle/ ∇ to select "Settings", then press \triangleright or **ENTER**.
- 5 Press ▲/▼ to select "Software Update Settings", then press ► or ENTER.
- 6 Press ► or ENTER to move to the menu to the right.
- 7 Press ▲/▼ to select "USB Memory", then press ENTER.
 - If you have not yet set the password, go to step 8.
- 8 Press ENTER to start checking data in the USB memory device.

- **12** Remove the USB memory device.
- **13** Press **POWER** to turn off the player.
 - Delete unneeded software update data using a PC after the software update process is completed.

Software Update Settings

In this player, the software version can be updated using either one of the following methods.

- Auto Update from Network
- Manual Update from Network
- Manual Update from USB memory device

Auto Update from Network

This function allows you to perform the update by accessing an Internet connection automatically to check if there is a new firmware version every time the player is turned on.

When using this function, it is required to perform the following settings in advance.

□ NOTE —

- Make sure that the LAN cable or the wireless LAN adapter is connected to this player and make sure that the wireless router/access point is connected to the Internet if using the wireless LAN adapter. (See pages 18–19.)
- Make sure to perform the communication settings. (See pages 46–49.)
- It may take time to access and download the update depending on the Internet connection and other factors.

M CAUTION –

• Do not remove the LAN cable or the wireless LAN adapter or unplug the AC cord while downloading or updating software.



Setup

- **1** Press \blacktriangle/ \lor to select "Settings", then press \triangleright or **ENTER**.
- 2 Press ▲/▼ to select "Software Update Settings", then press ► or ENTER.
- **3** Press \blacktriangle/ \lor to select "Auto Update Setting", then press \triangleright or **ENTER**.
- 4 Press ▲/▼ to select "Yes", then press ENTER.
 After this, an Internet connection will be made automatically every time this player is turned on.

Update process

- **1** When this player is turned on, the Internet connection starts automatically.
 - "Accessing..." blinks on the screen.

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• The current version of this unit software and the latest version of the update file on the network are displayed when latest version of firmware has been found.

To update this player software with update file, select "Yes", and go to step 2.

- If the latest firmware version has been already updated, nothing is displayed on the screen.
- 2 Press ENTER to start updating.



- **3** When the software is successfully updated, a screen is displayed indicating that the update process is completed.
 - If the update has failed, an error message appears. Retry the update after checking if the broadband Internet connection (pages 18–19) and communication settings (pages 46–49) are performed properly.
- 4 Press **POWER** to turn off the player before using again.

This function allows you to perform the update operation by accessing an Internet connection manually to check if there is a new firmware version.

□ NOTE —

- Make sure that the LAN cable or the wireless LAN adapter is connected to this player and make sure that the wireless router/access point is connected to the Internet if using the wireless LAN adapter. (See pages 18–19.)
- Make sure to perform the communication settings. (See pages 46–49.)

 - It is recommended that the USB memory device be connected to the USB2 terminal on the front of the plaver.

□ NOTE —

• A USB memory device can be used with either the USB1 or USB2 terminal. When two USB memory devices are connected to both terminals at the same time, in certain situations the USB1 terminal may give priority to Local Storage and the USB1 terminal cannot be used for Software Update.

- 2 Press **POWER** to turn on the power.
- **3** Press \blacktriangle/ \lor to select "Settings", then press \blacktriangleright or ENTER.
- **4** Press $\blacktriangle / \blacksquare$ to select "Software Update Settings", then press ► or ENTER.
- **5** Press \blacktriangle/ \lor to select "Manual Update", then press ► or ENTER.
- 6 Press ▲/▼ to select "USB Memory", then press ENTER.
 - If you have not yet set the password, go to step 7.
